Ice Maker

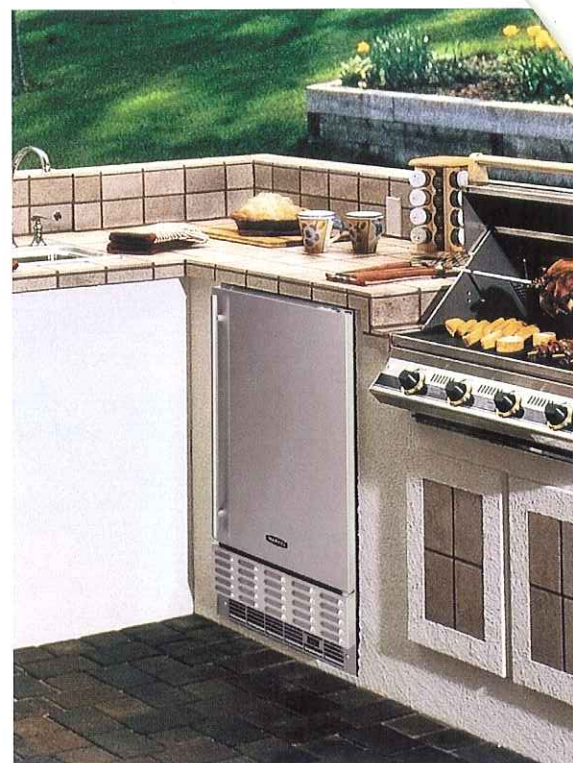

Convection Grill

A thermometer in the grill monitors the internal temperature and signals when the fare is ready with a beep and a light on the panel. Refrigerator
