### **Come on, baby, light your fire — more economically**

Here's a grill that promises to cut a barrel of crude oil a year from the average grilling household's BTU usage.

Fire Stone Home Products says its new Cook Number Grill uses half as many BTUs as the average grill, and "will save the average grilling household 6,240,000 BTUs a year, translating to one barrel of crude oil, just to use their grill."



The grill also takes the guesswork out of knowing when food is done, according to the company. It's designed with 10 precise settings to avoid overcooking. A food temperature sensor inserted into the food signals when it's done, removing any guesswork.
